

DIRECT RELIEF FUND

Tell Every Amazing Lady® received \$200,000 from the Fund for Health Equity for its work to increase access to healthcare services in underserved communities.

Tell Every Amazing Lady® collaborates with the Weill Cornell Medicine Meyer Cancer Center at New York-Presbyterian Brooklyn Methodist Hospital and the Center for Community Health at NewYork-Presbyterian Brooklyn Methodist Hospital. Throughout the grant period, we hope to eliminate health disparities by increasing enrollment of patients from underrepresented communities diagnosed with gynecologic cancers into clinical trials and improving compliance with recommended treatment by helping them overcome barriers of cost, fear, and misinformation. Enhancing patient navigation is part of fulfilling this grant to help achieve more equitable cancer care.
